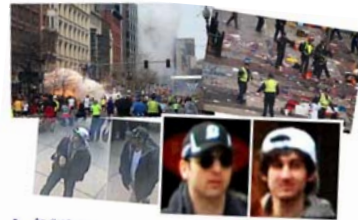

The Surrey Six Murders 'PROJECT E PESETA'

- Surrey, B.C. – October 19, 2007 - a "graphic mass-murder".
- "Cold-blooded" execution of six people, including two innocent bystanders.
- An ongoing gang war.
- The 'Red Scorpions' gang expanding their territory and establishing their reputation for unrivalled violence.
- The arrests of many of the gang's senior members was only the start of an investigation that had more than its share of complexities.



- April 15, 2013, two bombs went off near the finish line of the Boston Marathon, killing three spectators and wounding more than 260 other people.
- Within hours investigators released photos of the suspects.
- Four days later, after an intense manhunt that shut down the Boston area, police captured one of the bombing suspects, whose older brother and fellow suspect, died following a shootout with police that same day.
- Both self-radicalized Chechen brothers were motivated by their extremist beliefs and opposition to the US involvement in the wars in Afghanistan and Iraq.



The murder of Jun Li and the conviction of Luka Magnotta

- The case which made headlines around the world from the onset with the publication of the murder and it's staging to copycat the 1990's movie Basic Instinct.
- How the Montreal Police Major Crime Unit launched into a worldwide chase to arrest and the killer.
- The trial, which centered on a non-criminally responsible plea by the Defence.



Murder on the 403

- On Saturday, April 9th, 1994 Michael James Lovejoy was found dead in the sleep portion of his transport tractor.
- He had been shot six times at close range.
- The tractor trailer was parked on the north shoulder of the westbound lanes of Highway 403, one mile east of the Park Road overpass in the City of Brantford.
- Nothing appeared to have been stolen from the victim or the tractor-trailer.
- There was no evidence that the victim struggled or resisted the assailant.
- Approximately 300 citizen tips have been received by police.
- To date, police investigation has not revealed a motive nor a suspect in this homicide.
